

## *The projects in Romania*

The Scheytt Foundation currently exists exclusively to support the Good Samaritan charity in Romania. This was started in 1995 by Maria and the late Gotthold Scheytt, with the aim of helping those in need.

### *The charity consists of three separate projects:*

- the childrens' home (see further information) is the central focus of the charity. It was also founded in 1995.
- a further project is the support of Roma families in a nearby village. Alongside material support for these families, the children are offered the possibility of attending school regularly.
- families and individuals receive help, both material and in the form of personal support.

## *The childrens' home*

The central and largest project of the Good Samaritan charity is the childrens' home.

The renovated farmyard and house in a village near Kronstadt houses roughly twenty children and young people, all of whom are, for various reasons, unable to live with their parents. They live together over a long period of time in small groups resembling families and can stay in the home until they reach adulthood.

The children and young people are offered an upbringing in a stable relational framework, based on Christian values. Where necessary they are also accompanied and supervised by professional experts.

The goal of this work is to help the children develop their own potential by supporting them on an educational and a personal level. Despite their difficult start to life, they should reach a point where they are able to build relationships and live independent lives.
